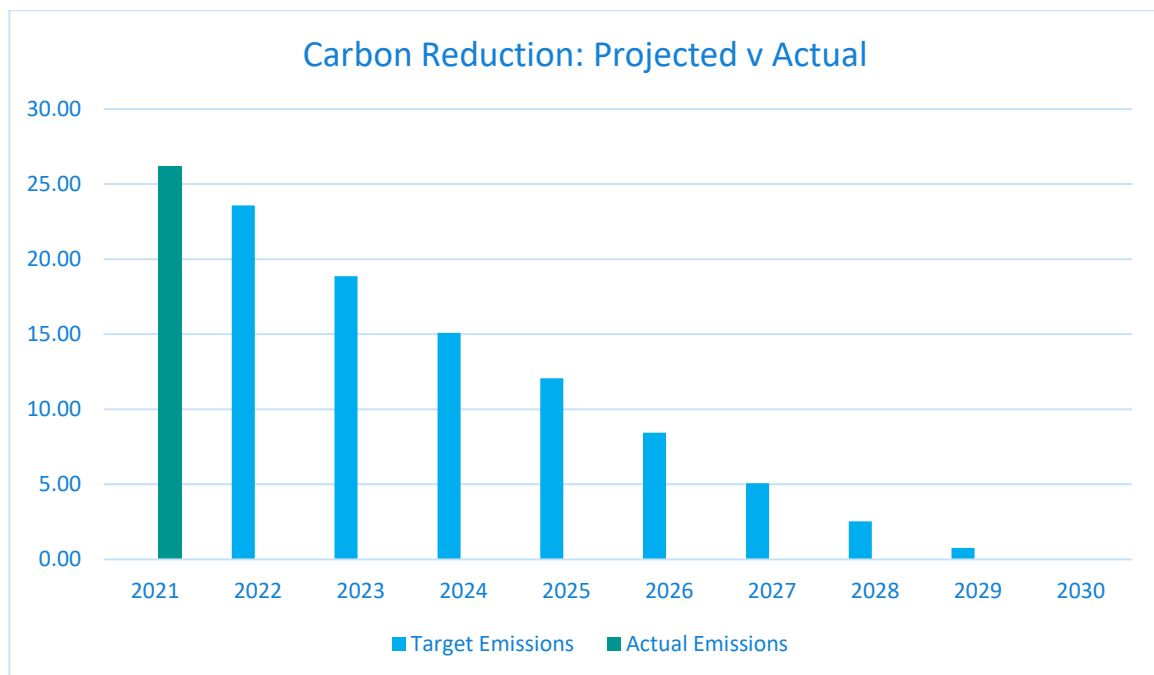

In order to continue our progress to achieving Net Zero, we have adopted the following carbon reduction targets.

We project that carbon emissions will decrease over the next five years to 12.07 tCO₂e by 2025. This is a reduction of 46%.

Completed Carbon Reduction Initiatives

We committed before the baseline measure was undertaken on the following environmental management measures and projects including removing paper from office use to a minimum, the offer of ride to work bike scheme. The carbon emission reduction achieved by these schemes hasn't been calculated.

In the future we hope to implement further measures such as:

- Include changing staff contracts to hybrid working with home working for 40% of the time.
- We will undertake 80% of our meetings online.
- Move to online document signing rather than wet ink.
- For business travel using public transport wherever possible.
- We are investigating electric cars for staff through a salary sacrifice scheme.

In future we hope to work with our landlord to reduce our leased office energy use further and install electric charge points.
